

Mountain Bike Trip!

North Rim of the Grand Canyon!

(Start & End in St. George, Utah near Las Vegas)

June 21-25 with Western Spirit Tours

We need to have 10 people commit to this trip by 12/25 in order to keep it "private" and want to hear if you are interested RIGHT AWAY (by 12/9) so we can hold the trip just for us.

This will be an adventure you don't want to miss! For intermediate skill levels with plenty of optional challenges for the advanced riders. Western Spirit Tours will guide us, cook for us, and carry all our gear. All we have to do is ride our bikes, enjoy the scenery, and set-up/break-down our tents each day. Tours with Western Spirit are totally fun and the food is fantastic!

Description & Itinerary

In addition to sections of the Arizona Trail, our route on the North Rim of the Grand Canyon includes a visit to Grand Canyon National Park and the highly acclaimed Rainbow Rim Trail.

This trail in the North Kaibab National Forest is one of our all time favorites. The construction techniques the rangers used to build this trail are the best we have found in the West. Because the grade rarely exceeds 9%, everybody feels like a hero. The climbs are gentle and consistent and the descents are smooth and flowing.

The North Rim of the Grand Canyon is at a higher elevation than that of the South Rim. So our route on this side of the canyon is a bit more challenging than that on the South Rim.

This is a great trip for those of varying skills, with some options for longer or shorter rides.

Price is \$1,185 per person and includes: Guides, Food, Support Vehicle, Campsites, Shuttles, Park Fees & Permits

Not Included: Transportation Bellingham to/from St. George, accommodations & food outside of the trip, guide gratuities, alcoholic beverages, sales tax. We will look into group airfare and accommodations if the trip is a "go".
